Wind Noise From Door Mirror Area

Symptom


Wind noise emanating from the right or left door mirror between 40 and 50mph.

Cause


Two concerns can potentially lead to wind noise from the door mirror area.

Potential causes;

1. The Run channel sash foam has gaps, or is missing.



2. Run channel sash bracket gap has excessive clearance at the mirror fixing point.



Application to Production Line

Application to Production Line will be confirmed at a later date.


Market Treatment

Repair on customer complaint only.


Repair Method

Run Channel sash foam gap or missing (A).





- 1. Remove the door mirror as described in MaRIS.
- 2. Remove all visible foam, be careful not to damage painted surfaces, or trim.
- 3. Degrease the Run Channel sash and bracket.
- 4. Apply a new piece of foam cut to the dimensions shown below to area A.
- 4. Ensure that the foam covers both the run channel sash and the mirror patch.




Use part number 06990-SA5-000 foam or equivalent foam with a maximum thickness of 4mm.

Run channel sash bracket gap (B)

Area of concern is at the Mirror base (C) shown below.




- 1. Remove the door mirror as decribed in MaRIS.
- 2. Degrease the Run Channel sash and bracket.
- 3. Apply a new piece of foam cut to the dimensions shown below to area B.
- 4. Make sure to cut a hole so that the door mirror stud passes through the patch.

Below shows the completed repair to the Run channel sash and sash bracket with the foam applied to both points A and B.



Re-fit door mirror as described in MARIS. Test Drive the vehicle to ensure that the noise has been eliminated.
